future generations.



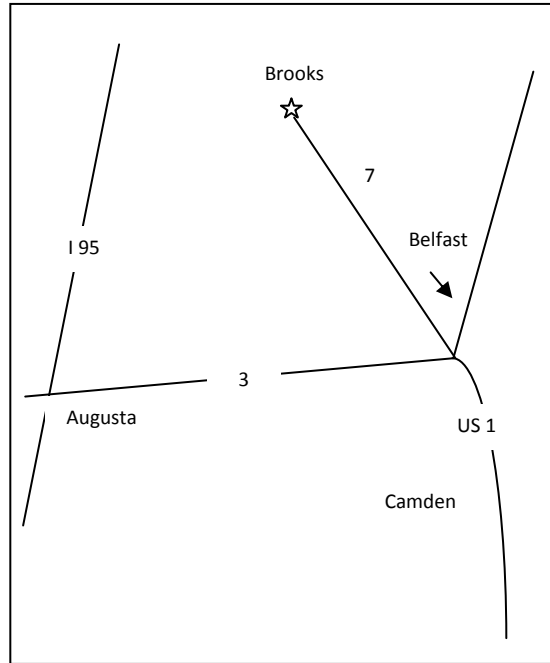
Party Caboose
